	Past Simple	Present Perfect
Budowa	podmiot + czasownik w II formie / -ed	podmiot + have/has + III forma (past participle)
Kiedy używamy?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – zakończone czynności w przeszłości – podajemy dokładny czas 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – doświadczenia życiowe – skutki widoczne w teraźniejszości – czynności, które trwają do
Określniki czasu	yesterday, last week, in 2010, ago	already, just, ever, never, for, since, yet
Przykład – twierdzenie	<i>I visited London last year.</i>	<i>I have visited London.</i>
Przykład – przeczenie	✗ I didn't visit London last year.	✗ I haven't visited London.
Przykład – pytanie	? Did you visit London last year?	? Have you visited London?

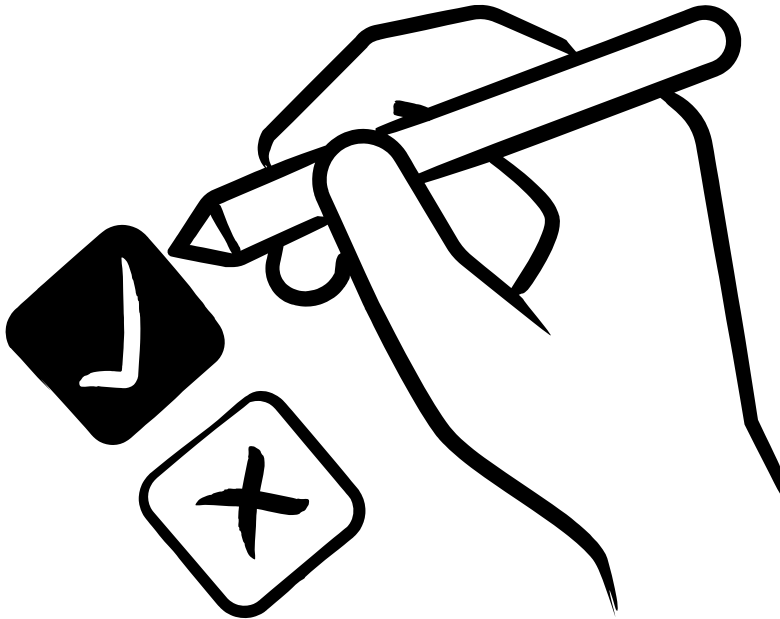
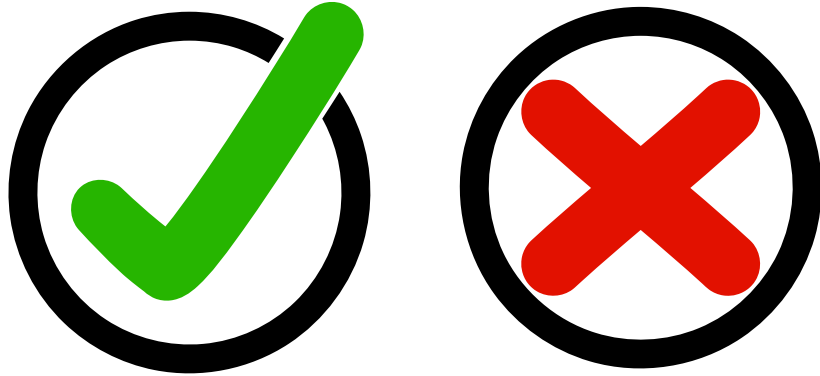
